CALL FOR PAPERS

Presentations may be in the following categories:

- 1. Original research.
- 2. An evidence based review of topics in rehabilitation research and/or clinical practice.
- 3. A unique or important case report with a focused literature review suitable for publication in the peer reviewed literature.

PRESENTATION FORMAT

- 1. Podium presentations should be ten minutes in length followed by two minutes for questions.
- 2. Abstracts should be 250 words in length.
- 3. Abstracts for original research and case reports should include Objectives; Design; Setting; Participants; Interventions; Main Outcome Measure; Results; and Conclusions:
- 4. Abstracts for reviews should include Objectives; Data Sources; Study Selection; Data Extraction; Data Synthesis; and Conclusions.

April 6, 2016 Submit completed abstract.

April 20, 2016 Decision for podium or poster presentation announced.

May 2, 2016 Submit PowerPoint presentation.
